JOB SUMMARY: This position is responsible for the safety and security of detention center inmates, personnel, and facilities.	
ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS: • Conducts security and inmate welfare checks; conducts routine head counts to ensure all inmates are accounted for at the beginning of the shift and at any other necessary time. • Controls and inventories material and equipment; search inmates and facility for contraband. • Escorts inmates throughout facility to court, medical and recreational areas, transport to other locations as necessary. • Issues cleaning supplies and toiletries; distributes mail. • Conducts outside perimeter checks. • Provides procedural and activity information to inmates; supervises inmate program activities; maintains inmate discipline. • Maintains inmate activity schedules; coordinates meal service; provides access to medical and dental care. • Ensures cleanliness of facility through direct action and through supervision of inmates during general clean-up. • Responds to disturbances and medical emergencies. • Ensures inmates' due process rights are upheld. • Ability to meet attendance requirements of regular and predictable attendance. • Ability to interact positively at work and be a good representative of the Lee County Sheriff's Office. • Ability to work with limited supervision • Performs other related duties as assigned
